### **Kayaking on Whiskeytown Lake**

**Limited to 25 people.**

### **Shasta Dam Tour**

**Limited to 40 persons.**

Guided tour. There is also a visitor center and auditorium. The tour comprises a 428-foot elevator ride to the base of the dam, and visits to the dam's inner galleries and the powerhouse among other areas. One of the most popular recreational lakes in California. House boating, water-skiing, swimming, fishing, mountain biking are among the numerous activities available at the lake.

The \$20.00 includes transportation, no lunch. Closed toe shoes required.



### **Lake Redding Golf Course**

**49 ½ and Guests ONLY or arrange on your own.**

The location of Lake Redding Golf Course being in downtown Redding makes this a great 9-hole or 18-hole course very convenient. The fairways and greens are primarily Bermuda with some Poa Anna.

\$20.00 for 9-holes. \$12.00 for golf cart for 9-holes. 18-holes can be played for an additional price. Transportation included. Rental equipment available.



### **Sundial Bridge**

The Sundial Bridge at Turtle Bay is a working sundial and is one of the largest in the world.

The sundial shadow traces such a large arc that it can record only four hours a day from 11 am-3 pm.

Turtle Bay Museum is the heart of the experience. It contains permanent, interactive exhibits and two large special exhibition galleries. Local and regional history is center stage in permanent exhibits in the Museum and Paul Bunyan's Forest Camp.

The \$25.00 includes transportation, no lunch is provided, but there is food service available.

Closed toe shoes recommended. Includes Turtle Bay's McConnell Arboretum and Botanical Gardens Tour (see below)



### **Turtle Bay's McConnell Arboretum and Botanical Gardens**

The Botanical Gardens portion of the McConnell Arboretum & Botanical Gardens is the newest addition to Turtle Bay Exploration Park. The Gardens comprise 20 acres of Mediterranean-climate display gardens, a children's garden, a medicinal garden, and two beautiful and unique water features. The gardens carry Turtle Bay's sustainability message and express a positive ethic about a harmonious fit between natural systems and human activity.

### **Redding Air Attack Base – RAAB**

#### **Limited to 20 persons.**

The RAAB was established in the late 1960's and is located at the CAL FIRE Northern Operations Center. RAAB is an interagency base between CAL FIRE and the Forest Service. RAAB responds to an average of 200 calls per year. The complement of aircraft assigned includes , Air Attack 240, which is an OV-10 Bronco, and two S-2T air tankers, T-94 and T-95. These air tankers are capable of carrying 1200 gallons of fire retardant. Also assigned to the base is Air Attack 503, a King Air. This aircraft is used as a training platform for new Air Tactical Group Supervisors students. (ATGS)

### **Fly Fishing On the Lower Sacramento River**

#### **49 ½ and Guests ONLY**

Wild Rainbows are big, tough and plentiful, and the river's controlled flows, combined with northern California's temperate climate – result in near-optimum fishing conditions.

Guides concentrate on the 16 trout-filled miles between Redding and Anderson, and the 30 red-hot fly fishing miles as the river winds its way toward Red Bluff.

The \$450.00 is for 2-anglers, includes transportation guide, equipment.
